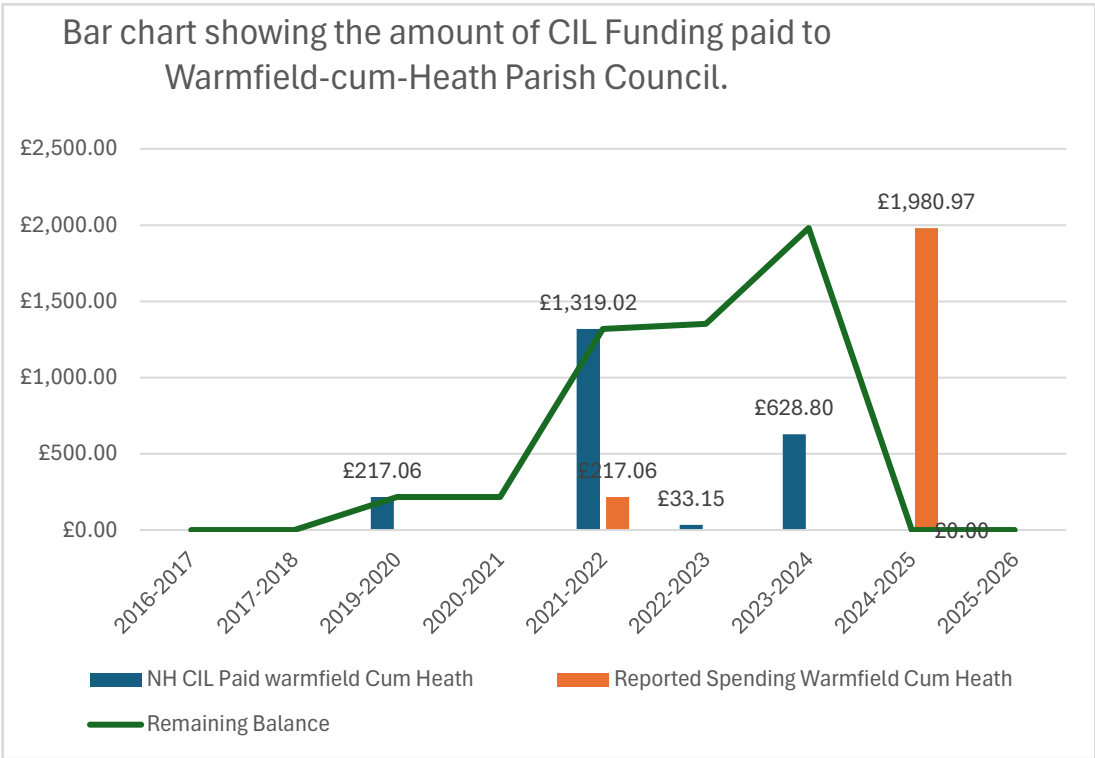


CIL Dashboard : Neighbourhood CIL Paid by WMDC to Warmfield-cum-Heath Parish Council

Community Infrastructure Levy was adopted by Wakefield Council on 1st April 2016. Twenty five percent of all CIL collected within Warmfield Cum Heath Parish Council is transferred to the Parish Council. Where applicable CIL Funds collected by WMDC are transferred to Town and Parish Councils twice a year as required by the CIL Regulations, any CIL receipts collected between 1st April and 30th September are transferred by the 28th October and any CIL receipts collected between 1st October and 31st March are transferred by the 28th April.

Town and Parish Councils are required by the CIL Regulations to report back to WMDC on CIL Spending. These requirements are outlined in Regulation 121 B of the CIL Regulations. CIL Funds are also to be spent by the Town Council within 5 years of receipt. Warmfield -cum Heath Parish Council have spent all their CIL reserves as reported in August 2025.
