- Consideration for a new community centre is on going with a parish questionnaire pending.
- On-going repairs have taken place.
- First aid course arranged.

Kirkthorpe Playing Fields

- Altofts Juniors continue to use the playing fields for their u12 girl's team; they have replaced the goal posts and maintain the pitch. There have once again been no issues with parking or complaints from residents, the area being well maintained by the team.
- A further replacement bin has had to be purchased again this year; it has now been taken into the centre to stop it from being stolen again.
- Gate repairs and a new combination lock added to the Playing fields.
