WARMFIELD – CUM – HEATH PARISH COUNCIL EXTRACTS FROM THE MEETING HELD ON 3 AUGUST 2011

<u>Community Centre</u> – This Item was taken before the main meeting.

The Clerk reported on the current financial position, which remains positive. He also reported that the blocked drains had been cleared and new manhole covers fitted, and that repairs had been carried out to the walls of the building, and a new fallpipe fitted.

New Paper Towel Dispensers have been fitted, together with new shelves in the broom cupboard, and the old Fridge and Microwave Oven have been removed. Following the consultation exercise carried out during the Village Fete, a grant application towards refurbishment of the Children's Play Area will now be made. Public Participation – It was agreed to ask WDH for an estimate in terms of surface improvements and cutting back vegetation along the rear access track behind properties in Kirkthorpe Lane. Acting Police Sergeant Macleod from Normanton NPT was present, and provided information regarding priority action in the Parish. He emphasised the need to report incidents, particularly off road M/cycles etc to the non-emergency telephone number 08456 06 06 06.

Clerk's Progress Report

- The memorial seat, in memory of John Crowther, and picnic benches have now been delivered and an estimate for siting and fixing is now awaited.
- It was agreed to make further contact with appropriate Officers at WMDC, with regard to the issue of Kirkthorpe Post Office.
- The Clerk reported that the requested grass cutting at Warmfield Meter was now being carried out.
- The Clerk reported on correspondence with senior Officers and Members at WMDC in terms of the possible closure of Normanton Market
- An Email has been received from WMDC confirming that overgrown hedges along the footpath which runs alongside Beech Lawns at Heath will be cut back.

<u>Finance</u> – The Clerk provided a statement on the current financial position of the Parish Council, and presented appropriate cheques for payment. He also reported on letters sent to the External Auditors – MAZARS, and the Internal Auditor – Mr Charles Kirk.
