WARMFIELD – CUM – HEATH PARISH COUNCIL EXTRACTS FROM THE MEETING HELD ON 18 APRIL 2012

<u>Public Participation</u> – District Cllr Dagger confirmed that a High Court Injunction has been secured in respect of the Boundary Lane Site, to prevent any further caravans from entering the site, and stopping any further development. He also pointed out that a retrospective Planning Application is to be submitted.

Cllr Dagger also confirmed that the promised 'Day of Action' in terms of the number of horses on Heath Common had taken place today, and that the number identified was below the number allowed, and therefore none had been removed..

Colin Aylward stated that the proposed Heath Common Transport Rally was on track to be held on 27 May 2012, and he took the names of Parish Council volunteers. Mrs Whiteley, who was accompanied by a number of youngsters, asked about progress on the redevelopment of the Children's Play Area, The Clerk confirmed that he had spoken to officers at WMDC, and that he would attend any meetings set up to move the issue forward. It was agreed to convene a meeting between Parish Councillors and interested parents as soon as possible..

District Cllr Blezard informed the meeting that she was to be installed as Mayor of Wakefield MDC in May, and would find it difficult to attend Parish Council meetings during her year of office. She was congratulated on achieving this high office. Community Centre – The Clerk presented a synopsis of the accounts for the Community Centre for 2011/2012, and set out proposals for 2012/2013 when the accounts would be directly controlled by the Parish Council. Cllr Gueli reported that the recent problems with the lighting system had now been resolved. Clerk's Progress Report

- The Clerk provided a further update on the proposal to install a Post Office branch in the Community Centre. This has now been confirmed as operating on a Tuesday every week between 12.00 and 4.00 pm, commencing in early May 2012.

- A letter has been sent to WMDC with regard to the problems of dog nuisance being experienced from the Marshall Hill Travellers site.
- A letter has also been sent to British Rail, informing them of the issue of broken down track side fencing between Goosehill Lane & Willow Lane.
- A letter has been received from Heath Residents Association, informing the Parish Council of an application being made to DEFRA to erect lengths of 'Birds Mouth' fencing on sections of Heath Common.
- An Email has been sent to WMDC Highways with regard to the state of the carriageway at the junction of Boundary Lane & Warmfield Lane in Warmfield.
- The WMDC Countryside Service has responded to an Email which reported the existence of two posts which have been erected on Common Land at Heath
